□ Step 1: Nomination Form

Fill out basic information about the Nominee and you, the Nominator, so that we may contact you in case of clarification or questions.

□ Step 2: Nominee Bio

A one paragraph overview of why the nominated person should be awarded. This can be submitted as an attached document and should summarize their accomplishments as it will be used in the event program.

□ Step 3: Articles/Letters

To present a comprehensive picture of the nominee, you may include **no more than five** news articles and/or letters of support from individuals or organizations written by or about the candidate.

□ Step 4: References

Three references willing to speak on camera or/and provide electronic photos. If the nominee is selected, these references will be a key part of creating a cohesive video that provides a well-rounded picture of why the nominee is deserving of the award.

□ Step 5: Submission

In order to be considered, **all of the above items** must be received by the Foundation by the **close of business Friday, September 29th, 2017**.

The HANF Committee relies on the entire nomination packet in selecting each year's honorees. The limitation on articles and letters of support will be observed; anything in excess of 5 letters and/or articles will not be considered.

All award recipients must be 21 to attend the event. By submitting this application you are agreeing to fulfill the nominator's role and submit the criteria listed.
